CAMP PROGRAM

The CSUB water polo camp is open to both male and females ages 8-18 years of age. The camp will be divided into two levels.

- 1) Novice level- individuals with less than 2 years experience. This group will focus on basic fundamental skills of the game as well as introducing basic team and tactical concepts.
- 2) Intermediate/advanced- offers a competitive learning environment for athletes looking to elevate their game. Campers will receive advanced individual instruction in addition to learning elite level team strategies and philosophies of the game.

Campers in both levels will receive instruction from knowledgeable and accomplished coaches and athletes. The camp staff is headed by the CSUB University coaching staff as well as members of the current varsity women's water polo team in addition to other accomplished coaches.

A camp T-Shirt will be given to all participants.

CAMP DIRECTOR

Jason Gall

Coach Gall moved to Bakersfield in the summer of 2008 to become the head coach of the CSUB Women's water polo team. Gall has been coaching both collegiate and club water polo for over twelve years. As a collegiate head coach, Gall has coached two DIII Players of the Year and over a dozen collegiate All-Americans. In 2003, Gall was named the DIII coach of the year after guiding Pomona-Pitzer to the DIII National Championship. In 2003 Gall was also named the Southern Pacific Developmental Coach of the Year for his work with the youth water polo players through the United States club system. He was a member of the USC water polo team, and has a BS in Exercise Science and a MA in Physical Education.

FACILITIES

The Bakersfield water polo camp will be held on the CSUB campus at the Hillman aquatic center. 9001 Stockdale Hwy, Bakersfield, CA 93311
Over night campers will stay on campus in the dormitories.

MEDICAL CARE

Each camper must provide his or her own insurance. Parents or guardians will be billed for any medical care given at hospital facilities. Camp medical staff is NOT responsible for administering prescribed medication.

ELIGIBILITY

Registration is on a first come first serve basis.

REGISTRATION & FEE

Full payment must be received by June 1, 2009 to reserve your spot for this camp.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All requests for cancellation must be made in writing. There is a \$100 cancellation fee for all camp cancellations made before June 1st. No refunds available for failure to appear at the camp.

GENERAL CAMP INFO

All water sessions will be held at the Hillman Aquatic Center: all deep 50 meter and 25 yard outdoor pools. Dry land, classroom and video will be part of the program and will take place on campus.

Day campers must choose between option 2 or 3 (see below).

Please note that we will have several evening water sessions from 7:00-9:30pm. Day campers are expected to participate and should have access to transportation on and off campus.

Option 1: Overnight camper \$425

Drop off 9:30am 7/6

Pick up 4:00pm 7/9

Includes 3 meals per day beginning with lunch on 7/6 and ending with lunch on 7/9. Must bring bedding and towels.

Option 2: Day camper with lunch and dinner \$350

Drop off 9:30am 7/6

Drop off 8:00am Tues, Wed, Thursday

Evening pick up times will vary (may be as late as 9:30pm)

Includes lunch and dinner Mon-Thurs

Option 3: Day camper- No food provided \$295
