CAMP PROGRAM

The CSUB water polo camp is open to both males and females ages 8-18 years of age. The camp will have 2 program options.

1) **Team Camp**- Register for the camp with a group of athletes from your HS or Club team and improve your individual skills, team tactics and strategies while building team chemistry and cohesion.

2) **Individual Camp**-Register as an individual or with a small group and receive advanced individual instruction in addition to learning elite level team strategies and philosophies.

Campers in both programs will go thru the camp together. Both programs offer a competitive learning environment for athletes looking to elevate their game and learn from accomplished coaches. Both programs will offer position training to focus on *YOUR* skills at *YOUR* position.

Campers will receive instruction from knowledgeable and accomplished coaches and athletes. The camp staff is headed by the CSUB coaching staff as well as members of the varsity women's water polo team in addition to other accomplished coaches.

FACILITIES

The Bakersfield water polo camp will be held on the CSUB campus at the Hillman aquatic center. 9001 Stockdale Hwy, Bakersfield, CA 93311
Over night campers will stay on campus in the dormitories.

MEDICAL CARE

Each camper must provide his or her own insurance. Parents or guardians will be billed for any medical care given at hospital facilities. Camp medical staff is NOT responsible for administering prescribed medication.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

Registration and Waiver must be completed along with payment received to ensure a spot in the camp. Camp will be open until filled. Dorms will house 45 athletes max with counselors on each floor.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All requests for cancellation must be made in writing. There is a \$100 cancellation fee for all camp cancellations made before June 1st. No refunds after June 1 or for failure to appear at the camp.

GENERAL CAMP INFO

All water sessions will be held at the Hillman Aquatic Center: all deep 50 meter and 25 yard outdoor pools. Classroom and video will be part of the program and will take place on campus.

Please note that we will have several evening water sessions from 7:00-9:30pm. Day campers are expected to participate and should have access to transportation on and off campus.
